The only thing that I struggle with is his style of teaching, which may be more my preference than anything he is doing wrong. Most lectures I leave class a bit confused on the exact steps or procedures for what we learned. I think it's because he heavily covers just practicing problems out in front of the class instead of going into why or how we are doing it (with words instead of numbers if that makes sense). For example, if I had step by step explanation for topics in class I feel like I would leave with more understanding, rather than just watching him do problems. However, he does do some explaining, I just wish there was more. Other than that I really enjoy this course and would 100% take another class from him. He is great!
